Our Sustainability Journey So Far

2007 – We planted 12,000 trees over 20 acres on site.

2015 – We installed solar panels, resulting in enough CO2 being saved to plant 10,000 trees.

2017 – We built two beehives on site. Owner Joanna takes care of them in her spare time.

2022 – We planted a wildflower meadow on site supporting wildlife and biodiversity.

2023 – We installed two electric vehicle chargers in our tipi car park.

2024 – We launched a new charity policy whereby we allow our team to volunteer during worktime. We offer a minimum of £50 for employees taking part in fundraising activities and we raise funds through internal events for charities including, The Trussell Trust, Cash4Kids, Save The Children and Meeting Needs.

We only work with suppliers who show genuine efforts in sustainability, that is why our team regularly ask suppliers for their sustainability policy.
